- Must be 21 or older
- Have an intellectual or developmental disability

## WHAT IS THE COLLEGE FOR LIVING?

Transitioning from home to an independent life can be both a difficult and exciting time. College for Living allows for independent living in a campus atmosphere and is tailored to young adults with disabilities. We offer daily support in a safe environment.

- 1 Bedroom Apartments with 1 Bath, Kitchen/Dining, Living room and all appliances
- Additional shared living space with kitchen, living and dining areas, and patio
- 4 hours of professional staff on site daily
- Additional supports and services available

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College for Living residents enjoy a responsive, nurturing, and supervised environment where they learn to take responsibility for their own lives and attain greater independence. Our program is designed to meet the unique needs of each resident. Semi-independent living is provided in a safe campus setting that creates a college-like experience while fostering growth for a transition to more independent living.

## TUITION & FEES

### Basic Program Package

4 hours/day (28 hours/week) Direct Resident Education shared amongst the 7 participants: person-centered, skill-building & transition to more independent living situation when ready

15 minutes/week/participant individual Personal Coaching: plan for subsequent week's support and education, review LT goals & adjust short-term goals

Access to Helpline and off-shift professional support: 24/7 availability for advice and remote supervision

Access to Day Spring Community Living vehicles for educational outings

Transition Planning & Resource Development

Monthly tuition: \$1,365.00

\*Additional one-on-one support may be purchased. Please see our Menu of Electives (below).

### Housing Expenses

HUD-subsidized units (6): must qualify for very low income status, fair market rent (currently \$612 per month), tenant pays 30% of income (earned and unearned income) regardless of fair market rent amount, HUD subsidizes remaining amount

Non-subsidized unit (1): no low income requirement, fair market rent (currently \$513 per month), utilities, wireless Internet access, cable television in common area, telephone access in common area

\*Private in-apartment cable and telephone services are additional charges that must be arranged between the tenant and the utility provider.

## MENU OF ELECTIVES

### Care Support

This service is designed to assist an individual in completing tasks and/or accomplishing other activities of daily living. They are not necessarily educational in nature. Examples of Care Support tasks may include medication administration, brief check-in and status assessment, and transportation. Rate quoted for this service assumes transportation mileage at or below 25 miles roundtrip. Additional fees may apply per additional miles.

\$40 for the first hour

\$25 each additional hour

### Educational Support

This service is designed to support the individualized goals and outcomes set forth in each participant's annual service plan by providing one-on-one educational opportunities over and above the Basic Package. Examples of Educational Support tasks may include grocery shopping, medical appointments, and checkbook management. These activities are always educational in nature and, therefore, require more time to complete than Care Support. Rate quoted for this service assumes transportation mileage at or below 25 miles roundtrip. Additional fees may apply per additional miles.

\$30 each additional hour

### Professional Services Consultation

Professional Services Consultation is a project-based service provided by the appropriate staff based upon the nature of the project and the expertise required. This service provides support for long term projects such as home buying, financial management, medical issues, and community access. It is priced per project and customized to the individual and the outcome.
